

SACBC Japanese Language School 2017-2018 Application Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in enrolling in classes at SACBC Japanese Language School. As of March 2017, many of our classes were reaching near full capacity; therefore, we will only be filling vacancies for the school year 2017- 2018. Accordingly, we are not accepting free trial students at this time.

If you would like to apply for the seats that might become available at the end of this school year, please submit the attached application form to our school office. We will start accepting 2017-2018 applications from April 1st, 2017. If you wish to visit our school and view some of our classes prior to applying for enrollment, please contact us by phone or e-mail to arrange your visit.

As for class enrollment for the next school year, we prioritize students in the following order: (1) continuing students, (2) siblings of continuing students, then, (3) new students who prove his/her language proficiency is equivalent to the students in on-going classes when the class capacity permits entry. Please also note that some applicants might be required to take a placement test upon filing an application in order for us to determine his/her class level.

Enrollment is NOT based on simple first-come-first-served basis. Please understand that a student who applies later might be accepted in a certain class, when he/she demonstrates language capability more appropriate to the on-going instruction level compared to other applicants who applied earlier. As for students with the similar proficiency level, we enroll students in the order of application acceptance. It is important to note that some students might be required to master Hiragana and Katakana during the summer break.

We will notify parents of applicants whom we can enroll for school year 2017-18, via e-mail by July 31st, 2017. Thereafter, parents of additional students we can accommodate will be contacted as the space become available.
